



Reverse Transfer Agreement Between the University of Michigan-Dearborn and Henry Ford Community College

In accordance with the expectations of Public Act 62 in the State of Michigan requiring that public universities establish Reverse Transfer Agreements with community colleges, this Reverse Transfer Agreement is by and between the University of Michigan-Dearborn and Henry Ford Community College and gives students the opportunity to transfer coursework from the University of Michigan-Dearborn to Henry Ford Community College to potentially earn the Associate Degree.

The signatories to this Agreement commit to work collaboratively to enable eligible students to obtain an additional academic credential.

Each signatory to this Agreement agrees to:

- 1. Appoint a contact person and liaison for the initiative.
- 2. Establish the appropriate criteria to identify eligible students.
- 3. Share student information in compliance with FERPA guidelines.
- 4. Develop a method to track participation and results.
- 5. Develop and document the system, processes, communication, and timeline supporting this initiative.

This agreement begins on December 11, 2012 and will remain in effect unless terminated by either institution.

The individuals executing this Agreement on behalf of the University of Michigan-Dearborn and Henry Ford Community College acknowledge that they are authorized to execute this Agreement. All parties acknowledge that they have read and understood this Agreement.
